Their father, John Blake b abt 1821 probably died between 1870 and 1880. Living with them is Mary A. Morgan age 10.														
In the 1870 Census the Morgan family of John & Mary Morgan and baby Mary A. were next door neighbors.														
The Sisters are now on their own and Nellie is housekeeping while Lizzie (Ellen) and John Jr. are working.
